Freedom to worship	Stay informed of the issues affecting your community.
Prompt & fair trial	Participate in the democratic process.
Keep and bear arms	Respect and obey federal, state, and local laws.
Vote in elections	Respect the rights, beliefs, and opinions of others.
Right to free and unperturbed media (transparent and informative!)	Participate in your local community.
Run for elected office	Pay income and other taxes honestly, and on time, to federal, state, and local authorities.
To pursue life, liberty and pursuit of happiness	Serve on a jury when called upon.
	Defend the country if the need should arise.
