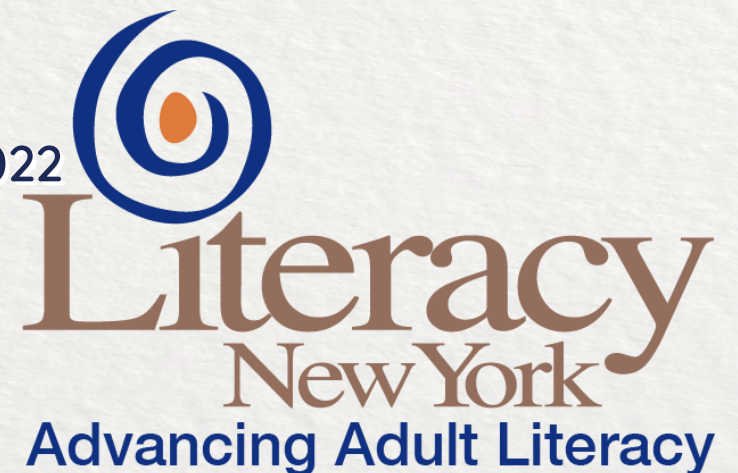

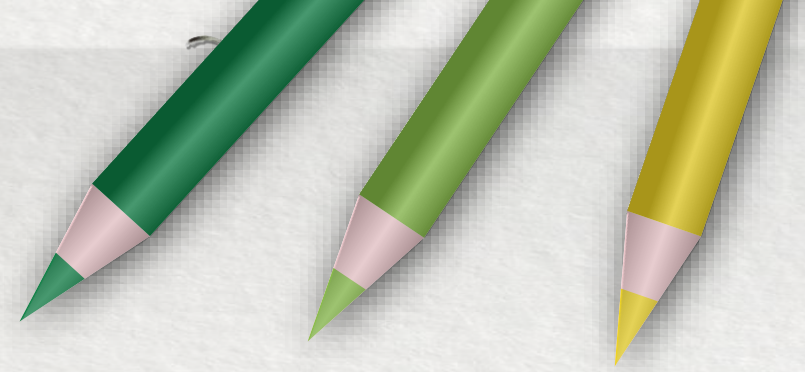

Supporting volunteer tutors for nearly 50 years

Several New York State Department of Education contracts

- Support and Technical Assistance Center for volunteer/CBO sector (volunteer tutors)
- Regional Adult Education Networks for traditional programs (paid teachers)
- Creator of first facilitated, asynchronous online tutor training (2015)



The genesis of I2O...

Why did Literacy NY create Intake to Outcomes (I2O) training?

“We’ve been training tutors for years...Why change?”

- Inconsistent quality
- Uneven trainer competencies; aging trainer corps
- Limited quantity of workshops
- Outdated materials
- Cost savings

How did Literacy NY develop I2O?


With an innovative partnership of content developers, instructional designers, and training experts...

- Built “up and out” of quality materials
- Continual vetting and updating
- Vision to reality!

How many tutor trainings do you offer each year?

You are paying for tutor training now...

Face to Face

- Trainer @ \$30/hr: \$450
(regardless of numbers)
- Administration: \$50 per
- Materials: \$50 per
- Online Enrollment: \$0

Total: \$550

Consider “no shows” and
“drop outs”...

Online with I2O

- Administration: \$30
- Materials: \$0
- Online Enrollment: ~~\$25~~
TCALL covering cost!

Total: \$30

Impacts of I2O online training



Thousands trained.

To date, 2000+ participants have accessed I2O online training

Students served effectively.

Programs utilizing I2O report meeting and exceeding state benchmarks and other measures of program effectiveness

Programs more efficient.

Programs report attracting wider variety of tutor applicants; students and tutors are matched quickly and continuously throughout the year; programs saving money

I2O Process-- Program

Step 1 → Step 2 → Step 3 → Step 4 → Step 5

Programs interested in I2O start at literacytexas.org/I2O to get the basics

If they're interested in trying the online workshops for themselves, they contact Literacy Texas, who sends a 'Getting Started' packet

Program submits application to Literacy TX; Literacy TX sends back personalized packet with codes and instructions

Program begins allowing tutors access to I2O, providing them with self enrollment and navigation instructions created by Literacy TX

Program tracks tutor progress; Literacy NY available for reports, technical assistance, etc.

120 Process-- Onsite

Step 1 → Step 2 → Step 3 → Step 4 → Step 5

Potential volunteer expresses interest in becoming a tutor

After program's application process, program offers pre-session (online or remote)

Tutor and program identify workshop(s); tutor provided with "Getting Started" email

Tutor self-enrolls training; program tracks tutor progress and deadlines; LNY provides technical assistance throughout

Tutor completes training and earns certificate; attends post-session at program; matches with student(s)

I2O Tip Sheet

Assignments

- Assign just one to two modules at a time- can always come back for more! Suggest pre and post sessions.

Time

- Allow no longer than 2 weeks for completion of 1 module; 3 for 2 modules. I2O will keep track of progress (not one sitting).

Tracking


- Use Google calendar or other electronic calendar alerts to keep track of tutors; have alerts emailed to you

Check In

- Send a reminder first week after assigning; Literacy NY can provide data

Access to I2O

- Tutors can re-enter I2O at any time; Databank resources can be printed



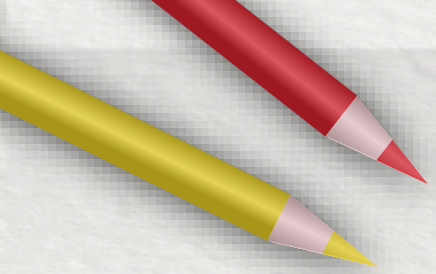
