



- "Products" of an adult literacy, higher ed, entrepreneurship, or job skills training program







- Currently 1 in 3 adults in Harris County (Greater Houston Area) function at the lowest levels of literacy.



Industry Specific

Industry Specific / Contextualized DL:

- specific platforms or software packages common to an industry
- automation and programming
- Note: DL is different for workers in the real estate industry and workers in the food service industry (integration).

Embracing a Digitally Driven Experience

- Materials: Worksite fundamentals plus site-specific, collaboratively developed supplements and experiences (the worksite is a learning lab)
- Online Learning Platforms: Use online learning platforms to deliver industry relevant content and facilitate collaboration for relative tasks
- Interactive Media: Use interactive media, such as videos and simulations, to support on the job thinking and problem solving skills
- Virtual Reality Tools: Use virtual reality tools to provide immersive learning experiences and team collaborations

"OG" English@Work, ATX 2005-2014

- Teaching English-language skills by contextualizing and customizing them and providing them in the workplace.
- Students made larger gains on various literacy measures more quickly than these more traditional approaches.
- Students also indicated that they felt more motivated to learn in a cohort of their peers that was situated within their workplace.

Merged with and became part of the larger Literacy Coalition of Central Texas (LCCT) in January 2014.
